## Taking a Deep Breath.....⊕

The season of Lent is here, a time of preparation for Holy Week and Easter. Without the journey, the impact of the destination is diminished. This year at FCC, we are taking the season of Lent as a chance to catch our breath before the most intense preparation for Miracle Day gets started. It's easy to get wrapped up in details (and debates about carpet color, or so the stories go!), but what's important is to remember why we're asking God for a Miracle in the first place. Re-focusing our attention on the journey to Easter, slowing down, taking a deep breath and remembering that building up our church is about building up the body of Christ, will help us to stay on track with our Miracle.

Throughout the month of March, though we'll be asking about carpet color, we'll also be asking the deeper questions about Miracle Day. What are we doing this for? What could the spiritual impact of this project look like? What future congregation are we making this investment for? How does our very work become an act of praise when given in the right spirit?

You will be receiving a letter asking you to consider supporting Miracle Day with your financial resources as well. We hope you will consider your commitment prayerfully, with a hopeful sense of what God can do through our congregation. You may give your gift at any time, all at once or spread out over the next few months, until the end of August. Cards will be provided for you to make your intentions clear. A box will be placed in the Friendship Room for cards and donations. All gifts will be recognized at the end of August.

In the "Urgent Prayers" section, we will run concerns about **church members and their family members**. Concerns for members' family will **run for one week**, unless specifically requested to run again. Concerns about members will run as needed. ⊕ ♥

We have created a **Prayer Book** that will be placed in the Friendship Room. The "**On-Going**" and "**Cancer**" concerns from the bulletin will be moved into our Prayer Book. You may add names to these lists at any time. ⊕ ♥

In addition, there will be a "**General Concerns**" section where you are encouraged to write in any concerns you have for co-workers, friends, acquaintances, etc. We also invite you to go back and write in updates as they occur, so we can give thanks for prayers answered as well. ⊕ ♥

You are, of course, **always welcome to share any prayer concern** verbally during worship or through the Prayer Chain. It is our hope that this new approach will make our Prayer Page more readable and useful, as well as give us a new way to lift people up in prayer. ⊕ ♥
