Why Christian Education?

Parents, I cannot emphasize enough how important it is that you as a family make a commitment to your, and your child's, spiritual development! I know that the idea of getting to church by 10am seems daunting because I am sure that, for many, Sunday mornings are crazy and chaotic at best. But I am asking each and every one of you to make a commitment to your children and to your family and to our church. I am asking you to make a commitment to attend Sunday school every Sunday that you are in town for at least one year. We are attempting to change the Sunday morning culture of this congregation, and in order to do that we need a core group of people who are dedicated to making that happen.

Committing to coming to Sunday school does 4 things: 1. It will lead to a stronger life-long faith for your child. 2. It will lead to a stronger family because you are all working together on growing your faith and your understanding of your faith. 3. It will help create a stronger congregation because Sunday school classes help people build friendships and develop bonds in a way that nothing else can. And, 4.
