Pastor Laura has requested that I write a paragraph explaining to you about the gravity of our current financial situation. If you have been following the donation information in the weekly bulletins, you might have noticed that we have not been meeting our monthly needs this year. In fact, there have been four months in which our donations have fallen more than \$2,000 short. Our donations for the year are about \$9,000 below what is needed to stay afloat. The only reason we have been able to pay our bills this long is because we have been spending the Julia Smith insurance monies that we received from her estate. Those monies are now all gone. We will begin spending from our local savings account this month, as we receive our workmen's compensation and building insurance bills. If we continue down our current path, we will have a difficult time paying any bills, much less payroll. Please be in prayer for our church.

What's going on with the Roof and the Air Conditioning?

I'm excited to tell you that our insurance company has agreed to cover the expense of completely replacing our roof. The adjustor found wind damage from one storm, and hail damage from another. They have already cleared everything with our roofer and have sent us a check for about \$80,000. The construction on the new roof should begin in a few weeks! Thank you to Don Jones for helping to make this happen!

At the last Council meeting the Council voted to contact the Board of Church Extension of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) to invite them to come and evaluate our Air Conditioning system. Church Extension will also help us go over the rest of the building to make sure there aren't any other problems lurking in the shadows. The evaluation is free. From there, we will apply for a low interest loan (based on the results from the evaluation) from the BCE. If they approve us for the loan, they will also help us develop a plan to raise the money to pay it back. God is in charge of all things great and small; and while the idea of replacing our A/C units seems overwhelming right now, God will give us the ability to do it! Please keep praying for the perfect solutions to any facility issues that arise.
